PRACTICE DIRECTIVE #19

AFFIDAVIT OF PERSONAL SERVICE IN CIVIL MATTERS

Explanatory Note:

It has been customary to attach a true copy of the document(s) being served as an exhibit(s) to the affidavit of service. This can result in a significant volume of copied documents being retained on the Court file.

Effective February 1st 2010, proof of personal service may be established by filing an Affidavit of Service in Form 19A with such modifications as the circumstances may require. This Affidavit need not include true copies of the documents being served as long as these documents are fully described in the Affidavit of Service. This description must include both the date of execution, the date of filing and the date the document was sworn (if applicable).

If the Affidavit of service does not contain a complete description of the document being served as required by this Directive, the Court may require the preparation of a new affidavit of service with exhibits attached.
