PRACTICE DIRECTIVE #32

***MOTION CONFIRMATION AND/OR ADJOURNMENTS
OF CIVIL CHAMBERS***

Explanatory Note:

The Judges and their clerks routinely review all files scheduled for hearing in civil chambers. Many of the matters on the list are adjourned to a new date with the consent of all parties. This directive seeks to identify the chambers matters that are likely to proceed so that the court can focus on those contentious matters that will proceed to hearing.

Effective April 1st 2010, Counsel for the Applicant shall file a Motion Confirmation in Form 32A no later than two clear business days in advanced of a scheduled chambers date to confirm the status of matters set for hearing. A failure to file a Motion Confirmation form may, in the discretion of the Clerk, result in the matter being struck from the list.

Practice Directive #8 is rescinded effective this same date.
